Honeycroft believes all parents and carers have a right to access affordable, quality services for their children. Honeycroft is a registered charity, founded in the late 1970's originally operating from Glebe Villas in Hove. The manager, Marion Silsby, identified a need to provide and promote education through play at a low cost for children in the city.

Today Honeycroft's services have grown to meet our objectives through a range of activities based at St. Barnabas Church Hall on Sackville Road. These include a nursery and Out of School provision for children aged 5 to 11 years old.

In addition to our children's services, Honeycroft runs a number of family support and play groups, plus room hire for the provision of education and training. Our nursery provides childcare for parents and carers attending the centre for training or leisure activities.
